Term	Description
Act 150 location	The fixed field in a patron record that reflects their place of residence (city, town, village in counties in or adjacent to IFLS-area counties, or other)
Bib [Committee]	MORE's Bibliographic Records and Standards advisory committee. Considers cataloging topics
Bib [-liographic Record]	A record that describes a title. These are shared among all MORE-member libraries
Bib-level hold	A request for any copy of a title. Most holds are placed at bib-level
Boopsie	A library app development company acquired by DemcoSoftware in 2016. MORE contracted with Boopsie to develop a MORE library app in late 2016
CABS	IFLS's Cataloging and Bibliographic Services. Provides cataloging services for MORE-member libraries for a fee
Cataloging certification	Beginning in 2018, the process required for library staff and volunteers responsible for in-library cataloging, in the absence of professional cataloging staff
Dashboard	IFLS's homegrown statistical tool found at dashboard.iflswb.org
Decision Center	A statistical and collection development tool from III
DemcoSoftware	A software development company that acquired Boopsie in 2016
DPI	Department of Public Instruction. The state department that oversees the operation of public libraries
Encore	Our main online catalog software, a subscription product from Innovative Interfaces, Inc.
First-come, first-served	A holds-filling method used by MORE until spring 2018. Items that can fill holds fill them in date-placed order
Flipster	A digital magazine product from EBSCOhost. MORE users access content via the online catalog or the Flipster app. The service launched for MORE in early 2017
Freading	An ebook product from Library Ideas. MORE users access content via the online catalog or the Freading app
IFLS	Indianhead Federated Library System. One of Wisconsin's 16 regional library systems providing legislatively-mandated and other services to all public libraries in the service area.
III	Innovative Interfaces, Inc. MORE's ILS vendor providing Sierra, our online catalogs, Decision Center, and other software
ILL	Interlibrary loan. Technically, any library borrowing beyond a library's collection, but typically used to refer to lending and borrowing outside of MORE
ILS	Integrated Library System. The software suite that enables patron borrowing and resource sharing. Usually comprised of databases, and staff- and patron-facing software to interact with the database
Item [Record]	A record that describes a copy of a title. Each library maintains item records for materials in their collection
Item-level hold	A request for a specific copy of a title. Some holds are placed at item-level; bib-level holds automatically become item-level holds when a copy is checked in to fill the hold
IUG	Innovative Users Group. Library customers of Innovative Interfaces, Inc. (III). They hold a conference annually in the spring

Term	Description
Lending library rules	A way of assigning borrowing parameters used by MORE since spring 2018. Each library establishes rules that apply to any items checked out at their library
Library Ideas	MORE's Freading vendor. This company also provides other products like Freegal Music and Rocket Languages
LMS	Library Management System. Another name for ILS
Loan rules	The set of borrowing parameters assigned by the system upon checkout. Loan rule elements include loan period, fine rates, renewals allowed or not, holds allowed or not, and maximum fine assessed. These settings are determined by libraries, but managed by IFLS staff
Local priority for holds	A holds-filling method used by MORE since spring 2018. Items that can fill holds first fill holds for pickup at the owning library before filling other holds in date-placed order
LSP	Library Services Platform. A term that better encapsulates all the software components that underpin modern-day library operations
MARCIVE	A vendor that provides automated clean-up of bibliographic records
MORE	My Online REsource. A resource sharing and automation consortium with IFLS-area public libraries as members and IFLS as service provider
OCLC	"A global library cooperative" from which we get many bibliographic records
Ops [Committee]	MORE's Operations advisory committee. Considers operational and circulation-related topics
OverDrive	A vendor of ebooks and e-audiobooks for libraries. MORE users access content via Wisconsin's Digital Library
OverDrive Advantage	A specialized OverDrive account that allows MORE to purchase content available to MORE users only, beyond the statewide collection
Owning library rules	A way of assigning borrowing parameters used by MORE until spring 2018. Each library establishes rules that apply to any items they own
PLSR	Public Library System Redesign project. An initiative launched in 2016 to evaluate library system services and make recommendations for providing more equitable, high-level service to public libraries
Preferred name	An individual's name that may be different from their legal name, included in patron records
RSCD [Committee]	MORE's Resource Sharing/Collection Development advisory committee
Sierra	The staff-facing software used to interact with MORE's patron and holdings databases
TWAM (This Week at MORE)	An email newsletter intended for all MORE-member library staff, sent weekly to the general MORE email list (more@lists.iflswb.org)
WPLC	Wisconsin Public Library Consortium. A collaborative group of Wisconsin library systems. Their current primary project is Wisconsin's Digital Library, the statewide OverDrive portal
